This week Sunday, I am leading in a youth service in one of the churches in the camp and will organize a prayer vigil in support of the demonstration in Burma. We will start off with some power point presentation of the shoot-outs in Burma. I am organizing this youth prayer meeting with Arep and Stella (Nagaland) Mary Wood and Michael Petty (USA) Shirley (AU) Teetoh, Gail Moe and me are leading the prayers. I will have a brief sharing reminding the youth of Karen struggle's history to reinstate our people-hood even in a foreign land.

We will have these people speak some gist <against> statements in support of the protest, and then we will divide the youth into groups to pray for the situation in Burma. This is what we are trying to do to show we care, <and> we want constructive and nonviolent change in Burma.

I personally don't want to sit here, do nothing while people are panting and fuming for freedom out there. I will not feel proud to go back and rebuild my home there when Burma gets better if we don't do at least praying right now.)

After the service we are going to distribute some arm bands to the youth, those who are committed to pray in their homes, to come to the church every evening (6:00) and pray as we have been doing this prayer meeting back in 1995 when the DKBA attached the camps.
